



## South Yarra Soccer Club: Insurance through FFA & FV

### BACKGROUND

When registering with South Yarra through Play Football, a proportion of the fees paid goes to Football Federation Australia (FFA) and Football Victoria (FV) as 'Player Registration'.

The Player Registration fee includes public liability & limited sports personal injury insurance. Before signing on with South Yarra Soccer Club each season, players are strongly recommended to familiarise themselves with the level of cover offered and ensure they have appropriate state or private insurance in place to protect themselves whilst playing soccer.
